



or EACH STUDENT MAKES HIS/HER OWN

Materials: (per student)

- Rug writing sheet for book cover (Scroll down to view it.)
- 2 - 9" x 12" construction paper (forms front and back cover)
- 2 to 4 sheets for story writing (Scroll down to view it. It's one with dog in corner.)
- Scissors and glue
- Crayons and pencil
- Yarn
- 2 Dog bones (optional)

Directions:

Teacher

1. Make copies as noted above of cover and inside writing sheets
2. Give students instructions (below)
3. When students complete their story writing and cover, collate, punch holes on left side, thread yarn through holes to "bind", add dog bones to end of yarn tails (tie knot around bone) as decor. Share stories!

Students

1. Color rug and dog. Put title of your story and your name on the rectangle. Cut out rug and glue to construction paper.
2. Write your story and put booklet together and read to a friend!

Story ideas: Name Henry's dog, tell why he goes everywhere with Henry, does he like going to school? Dogs can't go to school!-how does he get in? Is he invisible? What does he think of Miss Timberlane?
